Intro to K9NW & Continuing K9NW

Saturday February 4th, 2012 – MORNING SESSIONS

The sport of K9 Nose Work is designed to develop dogs' natural scenting abilities by using their desire to hunt and their love of toys, food and exercise. This detection-style sport focuses on teaching handlers the observation skills and handling techniques that support their dogs in successfully locating the source of odors with hides of varying difficulty.

Each **"Intro to K9NW"** clinic is a 3 hour indoor session with limited working spots. Each dog works individually several times during the session. A brief PowerPoint presentation reviews the differences between professional handlers and sport training, the development of **K9 Nose Work®** and the **The National Association of Canine Scent Work™ (NACSW)** along with searching examples to give participants a basic understanding of this exciting new urban game. In this Introductory clinic, we concentrate on indoor searches to build teamwork and foundation skills for dogs and handlers. All searches are tailored for each dog's needs and learning capacity. Hides are only as difficult as dogs can handle so they receive frequent rewards for success.

This clinic is appropriate for almost ANY dog – shy, fearful, those with dog issues, too old, too young or too exuberant, etc. The only dogs we cannot accommodate are those with serious aggression towards people. (Dogs with previous protection type of training are fine, just let us know in advance.)

The **"Continuing K9NW"** clinic is a 2 hour indoor/outdoor session with limited working spots. Each dog will work individually several times and each run through will be tailored to the dog's previous experience. The 2 hour format will be similar to the Intro/K9NW without the PowerPoint, building on previous skills and working with the first target odor, Birch. The **Prerequisite** is a class, clinic or workshop given by a Certified Nose Work Instructor (CNWI) at least 6 weeks prior.

Further Nose Work training involves additional handling challenges for indoor and outdoor hides, vehicle searches, blind hides, alert indications and teaching the dogs target scents. **Kimberly Buchanan** is one of the original Founding Instructors for the sport of **K9 Nose Work®**, having begun training in the sport in 2007. She and her Belgian Tervuren Oscar and Emmy were two of the first teams to title to an NW2 and Kim & Emmy were the very first to have qualified for the challenging NW3 title. They are the **only** team to have earned the NW3 Elite title (= NW3 x 3). Kim has also trained and competed in Herding, Tracking, Obedience, Schutzhund, Dock Diving, and Agility. They have competed nationally as part of the Purina Incredible Dog Challenge, AKC and USDAA Agility and internationally in the 2011 World Championships of Belgian Shepherds in Belgium. Kim has taught Agility and Nose Work classes and is enthusiastically helping to bring the sport of K9NW to other regions.
