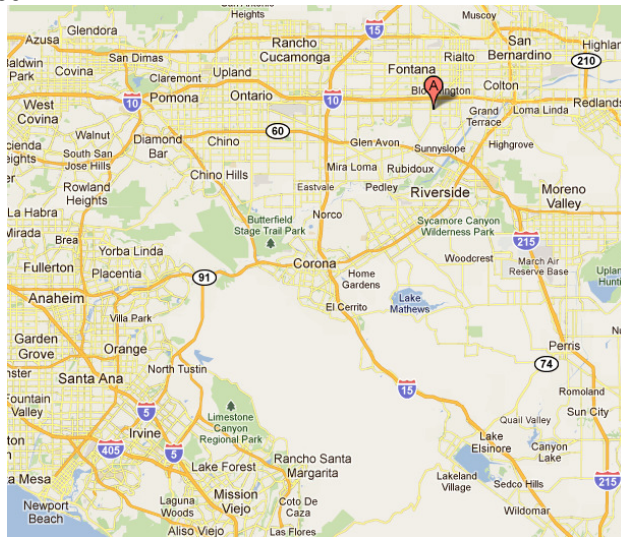
The goal of this training is to give you and your dogs a fun opportunity to practice trial-like searches in a novel environment. With multiple searches and levels, this event will require a lot of logistical planning so your cooperation is appreciated. **LIMITED ENTRIES!**

This event will be run similar to a trial but a bit more loosely to accommodate the small facility and number of participants. You will be on the honor system, as always! Your searches will be timed and the “Judge” feedback will be limited. We will make every effort to have the searches at the level you will be competing and the rules that apply but there may be an extra challenge or two! It is important that you only sign up for the appropriate level. There is the possibility of lingering odor in the areas adjacent to the searches. There will be no ribbons or placements.

**Video review: You will need to complete the photo/video waiver below to participate in this portion. After all runs are complete, we'll review the videos of your runs by level of competition and element.

**You may have 2nd dogs run by the same handler (if space is available) but the hides will not be re-set and the NW1/2/3 hides may be nested

**No Day-of entries will be accepted



FACILITY: This is a private dog club facility with a clubhouse in Bloomington, CA. It is about a 1-1/2 hour drive from Long Beach. The space is small so we will have to strategically plan search areas and paths of travel so please read the signage for potty vs. restricted areas. Please be conscious of other dogs and leave un-entered dogs at home if possible. Please bring a SECURE crate and shade as appropriate. Dogs must be crated in your car. Restrooms are on site and will be available between searches. There should be ample potty areas for the dogs.

PARKING: As I've done before, parking will only be in specific locations due to visibility to search areas

START TIME: Check-in at 2:30pm (do not arrive prior to 2:30pm) – briefing and walk thru of the first element at 3pm – details will be dependent upon number of entries at what levels – I will need to limit entries due to time restriction but I can't give an exact number until I know the levels.
